these devices. And the rules and regulations implementing 138, I think, are going to be signed this week by the Governor. So that process is largely taken care of for the people that you would see in an ambulance.

SENATOR JANSSEN: All right.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: This is the folks that you don't see in an ambulance, 'cause they aren't in an ambulance. This is your neighbor, or this is somebody in your building, or this is maybe the police officer.

SENATOR JANSSEN: All right. So they would have these machines then, say, in an office building,...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's correct.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...hanging on the wall,...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's correct.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...just like you would a fire extinguisher,...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's right.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...for emergency use only.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's right.

SENATOR JANSSEN: And they would have to...the company then would probably have to have two or three people in each department that...
