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that and move on to the next generation, which I think is next year, to make sure it's even better done. With that, I'd hope you'd vote for the amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Senator Cudaback, on the Chambers amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Ms. President, members, I'd like to ask Senator Kristensen a question, please.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Kristensen, will you yield for a question?

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Kristensen, you know, in order to qualify for payment under Lifeline, you have to...you have to be under one of the four or five programs, right?

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Yes, you...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Okay. Under the Chambers amendment, could you explain, will you still have to be under one of those definite programs?

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Yes, to the best of my knowledge, you're going to have to be under Lifeline, and to get Lifeline, to be eligible for that,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Yeah.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: ...you have to be receiving one of those programs.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Um-hum.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Jensen would call that means testing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Um-hum.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: For me, it's how do you become eligible for
