So I'll close by just reminding you again that if you have A bills you better look at them pretty hard, because at the end you may not get everything you want. And it isn't fair to any Governor, not just this one, but that's the little game we play, we send all the A bills, and we send the budget, and we let the Governor veto, and then we come back and talk about trying to override, and sometimes we do that, and sometimes we don't. If you can find a better system, I'll surely go along with you. But right now I don't know that...I don't know that it's not working. Thank you.
