SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...than they'd get away with doing in other states. There are some things that auto insurers can do in Nebraska that they cannot do in other states because those state legislatures protect their citizens, and citizens are not, by and large, protected by this Legislature, and Senator Landis knows it, if nobody else does, and he knows the difference between reality and perception, and he knows the reality confronting women in this state. The fact that they don't make much money, they are limited to dead-end jobs, they are going to be kept in a dependent, subordinate position, and then these men, who profit from it, can say we're not discriminating against them because they are women, these are the only jobs available, these are the only things they can do, this is what they want. Well, I, brothers and sisters, am not of that persuasion, and I don't care...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...what the insurance companies say, I don't care how paternalistically and frivolously the issue can be presented on the floor,...
