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basically it if you meet all the other qualifications or you lie and say that you meet them. But that's all it takes to register. You don't have to establish that you believe what the party believes in or anything else. So, it being such an easy matter to register with a political party, we should not make party affiliation a limiting factor on the people available for a candidate for Governor, one nominated who's going to be on the final ballot, we should not limit that person's choices. Why should we limit it? I have not heard anybody, I haven't heard Senator Bromm, I haven't heard Senator Schimek or anybody explain why we should not allow that candidate to select whomever he or she chooses. This is a different situation where, in the past, the public, in the primary, may select the person for Lieutenant Governor who is of the opposite party and may be one not even desired by the candidate for Governor. That's not what we're talking about, not where the public does it. We're not talking about the current situation where a candidate for Lieutenant Governor, to run with a Governor, is going to be...

SENATOR COORDSEN: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...nominated on that party's ticket in the primary, because that does not ensure that the person the public selects for Lieutenant Governor is the person that the one nominated for Governor would select. We still can have that dichotomy. We can still have that confusion. We can still have that warring between the Governor and the Lieutenant Governor because the Governor did not select the person he or she wanted. Maybe the public wants it that way. Maybe the public views the Lieutenant Governor as a check and balance on the Governor, rather than somebody who's to be like the Governor who will take over and rule as much like that person as possible. I just don't know what the public is thinking.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Cudaback, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. President, members, I won't reiterate what's all been said here because I couldn't if I wanted to, but I'll just make one point here. We're not doing anything here. We're making it available so the people can do this. This
