SENATOR COORDSEN: You've heard the motion. Those in favor please say aye; those opposed nay. Aye/nay, I'm sorry. We'll start over. You've heard the motion. Those in favor of advancing LB 103 please...or 703, please say aye. Those opposed nay. Well, it worked just as good the second time as it did the first. (Laughter.) (LB) 703 is advanced. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (LB) 703A, Mr. President. No E & R. Senator Wickersham has an amendment to the bill. (See Wickersham amendment, AM0640, on page 822 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Wickersham, on your amendment.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Thank you, Mr. President. I'll be brief. There was simply an inappropriate reference, in the A bill as filed, to the fund that the monies are to come from. The A bill, as drafted, said, County Employees Retirement System Expense Fund, it is supposed to be the Deferred Compensation Fund. That's all the amendment does.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. There are no lights on. Did you wish to say anything in closing? Closing is waived. The question before the body is the adoption of the Wickersham amendment to LB 703A. Those in favor please vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Wickersham's amendment.

SENATOR COORDSEN: The Wickersham is adopted...the Wickersham amendment is adopted. (Laugh.) Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: We're deteriorating fast up here. Motion, Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I would move we advance LB 703A to E & R for engrossing.
