SENATOR CROSBY: Your option is to take it up, or lay it over.

SENATOR BAKER: I don't know what the amendment is.

SENATOR CROSBY: It's a kill motion on LB 612. Senator Beutler has filed a kill motion on 612. Your option is to take it up now and discuss that kill motion, or to...

SENATOR BAKER: ...to lay it over.

SENATOR CROSBY: ...lay it over.

SENATOR BAKER: I think we will lay it over in deference to the Speaker, please.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. No objections? It's laid over. (LB) 54.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 54. Senator Smith, I have Enrollment and Review amendments to that bill, Senator.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Madam President, I would move the E & R...the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 54.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 54. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted. Do you have anything further on 54?

CLERK: I have nothing further on 54, excuse me, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Madam President, I would move the advancement of LB 54 to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to advance LB 54 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. It's two minutes to eleven, so we will now move
