CLERK: Mr. President, the first motion this morning, Senator Schimek would move to suspend Rule 3, Section 13, to permit canceling and rescheduling hearing on LB 455.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Schimek, you're recognized on your motion to suspend the rules.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you. Mr. President, members of the body, I don't generally like to reschedule bills once they've been scheduled, but this is a scheduling forward of a bill that was to be in committee this Thursday, on March 11, and we want to reschedule it to next Wednesday, March 17, which will give us at least a week's notice on doing that. So with that caveat, the bill's introducer is going to be out of town and I thought since we would have a week's notice, that it would be perfectly appropriate to do that. So I would just ask your compliance with this. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. Is there any discussion on Senator Schimek's motion? Senator Schimek, you're recognized to close. Senator Schimek waives closing. The question before us is the motion to suspend rules to reschedule a hearing. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to suspend the rules.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The motion is agreed to. Members, while the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do hereby sign LR 34 and (LR) 35. Mr. Clerk,

CLERK: Mr. President, if I may, right before (LB) 386, two hearing notices; cancellation of a hearing pursuant to the motion just adopted and rescheduling of that hearing, both reports signed by Senator Schimek.

Mr. President, (LB) 386, a bill by Senator Bohlke. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 13 of this year, at that time referred to the Education Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill at
