kept quiet and said, here's your \$100, and I appreciate your not having said anything about the unsoundness of this beast. And the fellow said, unsoundness of this beast, I don't even know what you're talking about. I had never seen a creature like this before in my life and I was examining it to see if I could tell which end was the head and which end was the tail. So this bill was even worse than that, in my opinion. What my first amendment will do is go to the part of the committee amendment which is talking about a rebuttable presumption, and this is the language that my amendment would strike from the committee amendment: There shall be a rebuttable presumption that any person who has a container containing alcoholic liquor, either opened or unopened, within the physical reach of his or her arms has actual physical control over such alcoholic liquor. Senator Schellpeper, I need to ask you a few questions to help me with what I am trying to do here.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Schellpeper.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: This portion of the amendment starts by saying, for purposes of this section. The section that is referred to is talking about what specifically?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: I'm trying to find where you are at, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. That's right, I didn't read it. Okay, on page 2, in line 3...

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...23,...

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...beginning with the word "There"...

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Um-hmm.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...strike all the language through the period
