all, but I've been listening to it here this morning and some conversations and comments that's been made, I thought maybe I would. And one of the things, I guess, I want to address is one of the comments that Senator Chambers had made earlier about adults getting an attorney and getting out of these different situations that they get into. This also happens with teenagers, with minor in possession. You may pick up several teenagers in a group for minor in possession. Some of the parents don't condone the drinking. Those children will probably come in and plead guilty. Then you have others that the parents do condone the drinking. They will go spend the money, hire an attorney. They'll come in with an attorney and a lot of those will either get dismissed or reduced or whatever happens, so it happens with teenagers the same. And I'm not standing up here and trying to say that we need to legislate parenting because I believe that's impossible, but I also agree with Senator Chambers. Unless my memory has failed me because of being here too long or because of age, but I don't believe I have ever introduced any legislation that has put more penalty on bills. And one of the reasons I have not done that is I feel that we have enough laws on the statutes right now, if the prosecuting attorneys and the judges will carry out what penalty we have. They're already here. We just have to do something so that they're implemented. And with minor in possession, it's a very difficult issue. To me it's very difficult to enforce. Physical control, possession, in my opinion, is a matter of a lot of different opinions when it comes to prosecuting attorneys and judges. And I could relate to several incidents that's happened out there over the years that I was in law enforcement that happened, and it happens because of money and because of people hiring attorneys to defend different people, teenagers and adults alike. I'm not sure whether I'm going to support this bill, but I just wanted to stand up and make a few comments on it as what's out there and I guess I have tried to deal with putting judges on the election ballot, I've tried to put them on the rotation of the ballot, and I guess I wanted to bring that issue up again. I'm not targeting any judge in specific. I'm just hearing comments from the people out there. I'm hearing comments from the teenagers. They don't respect our judicial system anymore. I don't know what you do about it. I don't have the answer to that. But I do want you to think about every time we put more penalty on the books out here, are we enforcing
