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manipulate identification one way or another to make it look like they are the real thing, but they are not used by the State Patrol. When a sting operation is pulled, they usually try to catch that establishment at a busy time, because when they are busy is when they will make mistakes. And I say, yes, they do, definitely, they do make mistakes. They'll look at an ID and misread it. But those IDs that the State Patrol uses are a legitimate ID, and I'm not saying that every one that the State Patrol uses to come in and pull a sting looks like he's 30 years old, nor do they look like they're 15. They're...they are questionable in the way that person looks. So, really, the sting operations that the State Patrol uses are a little questionable from time to time. What usually happens, when a retailer...when a retailer is caught selling to a minor, it happens at a busy time. They make mistakes, absolutely they make mistakes, and if they make those mistakes then they should be fined, closed down, pay a penalty or whatever it is. You cannot...you cannot avoid something like this happening all the time. I...I...but that person...that person's business is on the line and if he has to close down for a period of time, you know that's going to do, especially in places that are close to some...to other states where it's pretty easy to go across the state line to another establishment. You know, if you have food in there, the problems are bad enough right now with people going across over to the casinos to buy a five dollar meal that would cost you ten dollars in a reputable restaurant, not that those aren't reputable places across the border, but they are up against...they're up against it in the cities that are close to casinos and so on. We don't have that in this state, so they have to fight that too. Anyway, I just wanted to show you the retailer's side of this. And if the amendments keep getting...getting cut down, as Senator...
