SENATOR JANSSEN: Well, that's fine. I'd just hate to be duplicating something we already have, but, if not,...

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...a double backup isn't all that bad either.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yeah, if you have some memory of that, we'll go back and double-check for sure.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Okay. Thank you.
