available so that we can take advantage of what's in existence and not add to them. But to be able to add to training, to identify people who are there now, that people that need services have no idea that they're there, the whole purpose of the initial money is to do this identification. Even to...it would be open, you know, as to whether you have to have the same geographical areas as the six regions that are now set up to deal with this. We have left that open so once we can identify the needs for services in the various parts of the state we can construct it accordingly. What we don't want to do is layer more bureaucracy. We don't want to spend dollars unnecessarily. We want dollars to be able to reach out to people who are caregivers and who, in effect, in the end become victims themselves and, at the same time, be able to eliminate, to help slow down the need for placing many of these individuals into institutionalized care which is just tremendously more expensive. So I feel that we have constructed the bill well. We heard, either in verbal testimony or in written testimony from virtually every healthcare organization and group within the state of Nebraska in support of this legislation and, basically, nobody in opposition. And I would hope that let's go ahead and get on with the vote, let's move this thing forward. And I certainly, if you...if you have any further questions, Senator Beutler, would be glad to address those with you, but I would ask let's move this forward. Thank you.
