the State Patrol will conduct either in conjunction with or under the guidelines adopted by the State Patrol. And I think the guidelines is the key word here because the State Patrol, along with the Liquor Commission, will adopt the guidelines, and that's going to be very important on these here stings, and they could agree with that. But it's very important that we keep the two issues, the minor's driver's license and the retailers in the same bill. We've had legislation before and it has never gone anyplace because it turns into a dog fight with one or the other, and I think as long as keep them together and we're dealing with the same...same issue, that's very important. With that, there was some discussion the other day about several amendments. We've had some amendments drafted and we could go to them now, Madam Chairman, if you want to.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Schellpeper. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, the first amendment to the committee amendments this morning, Senator Schellpeper, AM0734, Senator. (See page 895 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Schellpeper, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Madam Chairman. The first amendment, Senator Beutler had quite a concern when we discussed it last time, on line 17 in the committee amendment, with "truthful responses to inquiries." That's when they would go into the liquor establishment and they would ask for the ID or ask them if they were actually 21, and he had a problem with the truthful response. We are going to strike in line 17 of the committee amendment, after "identification", we'll strike "and truthful responses to inquiries" and then go on, and then we will insert in that area "upon request." So it doesn't have the truthful response to inquiries. It's a very straightforward amendment. It...Senator Beutler said it would take care of his concerns with that part of it. I'd be glad to answer any questions. Thank you.
