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SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: We'll make a copy and have them passed out, Senator.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I was concerned, what...one of the issues that Senator Chambers raised was advance notice to retailers. Surely, there isn't, Senator Schellpeper,...

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Yes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: My question is, surely there is not advance notice to retailers under any circumstances?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: No, there isn't. No, there isn't. No advance notice whatsoever.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President and members of the Legislature, this is a football state. This...I'm going to ask Senator Pat Bourne a question or two because he is still young enough to be aware of what football is about.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Bourne, will you yield for a question.

SENATOR BOURNE: Oh, it would make my day.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Bourne, have you ever coached a football team before?

SENATOR BOURNE: No, sir.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Have you ever played football before?

SENATOR BOURNE: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Have you observed football being played?

SENATOR BOURNE: Yes.
