There's old Senator Byars wants to make everybody wear a safety belt, but he doesn't mind having foisted on every law enforcement agency in the state an ineffective way to protect children from being sold liquor by these drug dealers, as I call them. Those are the inconsistencies I had mentioned that I'm going to bring out. It's easy to pontificate and say, I want to save lives. Well, if they get that alcohol and get in the car, they going to save lives, even if they're wearing a seat belt? Craziness, outright craziness. But the thing I'm pleased about is the fact that...
