lying about having dealt with a situation, and they don't think there's anything wrong with cops failing to file reports when they ought to. Had there not been the involvement of citizens, this never would have come to light, never. So when I tell you these cops lie and they cover up, believe it. And, by the way, I suspect that Mr. Griffiths is a white man, because of the position he holds at Union Pacific and the fact that they took seriously what he said, took it seriously enough to investigate these other officers. So when we have a bill that we're considering and it involves the illegal dispensing of liquor to young people and the focus is on the young victims rather than the perpetrators, the Legislature is right in line with what those two cops did in this situation, which is to help the perpetrator, protect the perpetrator, cover for the perpetrator. I'm afraid my naive colleague, Senator Landis, is not going to get what he hoped would occur, namely a rejection of the committee amendments. Senator Landis, the liquor industry simply is too strong and they're going to have their way with this Legislature, but they'll have it over my...

SENATOR CROSBY: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...opposition. I started to say my dead body, but when I consider I'm dealing with drug dealers, they might arrange for that to take place. I hope that there will not be acceptance of the committee amendments. If you're serious about what LB 26 (sic) was designed to do, as Senator Landis pointed out, start with the document that was favored by all of these people who testified for it. And we'll still have some disagreements, but at least we don't have side issues injected, as is done by the committee amendments, which overshadow the bill itself.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Chambers. There are no further lights. Senator Schellpeper, you're recognized to close on the committee amendments.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Madam President and members. The committee amendments, in their current form, basically we've taken out the compliance checks.
