The bill in its current form, with the committee amendments, I think is a very good bill. We have a couple more amendments on the actual bill. We have several minors that are not 21 yet that are married and have a job. And I think if we're going to do it for the adults, we should do it for the minors also. We also want to change the DWI or MIP this is called from a misdemeanor to an infraction. We're trying to move forward with this bill, we're trying to help minors that are currently out there with alcohol. I think the bill in its present form, once we get to it, will be a good bill. These committee amendments are very important to this bill. I don't have to tell this body, but they're very important to keep everything going forward. The original bill is not going to pass. We need to keep the committee amendments moving along with the bill in their current form. We've made a lot of concessions on this...on the committee amendments, so I would urge the body at this time to support the committee amendments, let's get on to some other amendments, onto the actual bill.
