the house is under call. All present and accounted for. The question is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 126. Senator Schellpeper has requested a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk, please call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 952-953 of the Legislative Journal.) 11 ayes, 27 nays.

SENATOR CROSBY: The committee amendments are not adopted. I will raise the call. Before we continue, I do want to mention to you, so you understand where your nice cookies, from the Girl Scouts, came from this morning. The Homestead Girl Scouts Council provided them through their troops, and they come to you through the courtesy of Senator Schimek. Thank you, Senator Schimek. I'll raise the call. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, the next amendment I have to 126, Senator Schellpeper, I have AM0770 in front of me, Senator. Starts on page 4, line 14.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Just pass over it.

CLERK: Then I have one other amendment from yourself, AM0768. It's the one that inserts new sections. Pass over that? I have nothing further pending on the bill, Madam President. I'm sorry, I do have...no, you don't. Senator Janssen would move to indefinitely postpone LB 126. Senator Schellpeper, you can lay the bill over, if you're so inclined.

SENATOR CROSBY: The bill is laid over. Mr. Clerk, LB 314.

CLERK: (LB) 314, Madam President, a bill by Senator Bohlke. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 12, referred to the Education Committee, advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Bohlke, you're recognized to open on LB 314.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Thank you, Madam President and members. I'll take one moment here to pick up my file folder that just fell over, with all my notes. Let me do a brief history to remind
