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Senator Coordsen and I worked hard on that bill last year. He's not here today, but I think that he was very supportive in making sure that each year we wouldn't...every time there was an error, we wouldn't have to come back to the Legislature every year, introduce legislation, take up floor time, hear the situation of that particular school district, and debate it that year. This would give a mechanism to react to those situations. So I think, besides the benefit to the schools, I think there's a benefit here on the floor so that we have a mechanism that can react. And so, if you have any questions, if you look over this bullet sheet that's entitled "LB 314", and then turn to the back, you will see that dollar amount that is left over from the appropriation last year. Thank you.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you, Senator Bohlke. Senator Raikes.

SENATOR RAIKES: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein, members of the Legislature. Another point I wanted to raise is that along the lines of mechanisms that schools now have to address these situations, and I certainly agree that they can be serious financially, schools typically have cash reserves. There isn't, as near as I can tell, any mention of the amount of the cash reserve that the school has in the bill. I would suggest that two different...or two schools that face roughly the same...two schools that face roughly the same situation, in terms of special ed, or a group home, or something like that, might be able to deal with it quite differently, depending upon what they had in the way of cash reserve. So I would certainly think that that is something that ought to be recognized. I would also think that the one-third payback per year may make some sense in the case of a group home or a special ed student, but may not make much sense in the case of a clerical error. The clerical error would be repaid within a year. So, I guess, what I would suggest is that maybe these and some other issues, the total fiscal note and so on should be addressed. And one possibility would be to try to do that between now and Select File. So, with that, I conclude. Thank you.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Senator Cudaback.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. President, members, I forgot to say the one thing I liked about this bill specifically, when it was
