SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Lieutenant Governor, members of the Legislature, I don't think that a motion to indefinitely postpone is the right motion either, because we do have a problem we want to resolve and I think everybody wants to resolve it. Therefore, I'm going to withdraw that motion. I filed another amendment which should take us to eleven-thirty and then maybe we can all get some more information and operate on a little higher level of information on this bill. So, for the moment, I withdraw the motion to indefinitely postpone.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The motion is withdrawn. We will now proceed to the Select File business, at which time we will then return to LB 608. Mr. Clerk, LB 67A.

CLERK: Mr. President, a reminder, Business and Labor has an Executive Session in...underneath the south balcony now. Senator Smith, (LB) 67A, I have no amendments to that bill, Senator.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I would move the advancement of LB 67A to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question before us is the advancement of LB 67A. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (LB) 113A, Senator, I have no amendments to 113A.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 113A to E & R for engrossment.
