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March 16, 1999 LB 150

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Landis. The question before us is the Landis amendment to the committee amendments to LB 150. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Landis' amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is adopted. Discussion on the committee amendments? Senator Bromm, you're recognized to close on the committee amendments. (See AM0437 found on page 753 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you, Mr. Lieutenant Governor. I think everything has been discussed fully now. The committee amendments have been amended by Senator Landis's amendment. I just encourage the body to adopt them and advance the bill. Thank you.
