PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...told you all where to go. Now there are various bills that I have which he now is speaking very strongly against, but he was too cowardly to appear before the Judiciary Committee and speak against them. I'm going to put my light on again.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to continue.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President. One of them had to do with felony murder. When that bill was on the agenda, the Attorney General and prosecutors were in the Judiciary Committee hearing room. They were there testifying on other bills. They knew I would skin them, if they spoke against this bill, because they could not defend their position, so all of them, like little sparrows on a wire, and you throw a stone that falls near them, they all disappear, not a prosecutor stayed. The Attorney General fled the scene. And Senator Robak even said, when we were in our proceedings, where's the Attorney General? Where are the prosecutors? And I said, like the woman who was brought to Jesus in the act of adultery, and He said, where are those who are going to stone you? Where are your accusers? She said, Lord, I have none. When Senator Robak wondered where my opponents were on this bill, I had to say, Senator Robak, there are none. Then from the safety of his office, your Attorney General begins to make these inaccurate, false statements about the legislation, and you all swallow it. You swallow it. And now you're going to pay. I've had some of the senators and others tell me that they think Judge Kopf may grant a license to the facility, and how that would be assuming too much authority. And I said, well, if he does and they don't like it, they can appeal it. But I think Judge Kopf has had it up to here with your Attorney General. I also have a document from that same court where he showed where the Deputy Attorney General, Kirk Brown, had violated the lawyers ethics in his filings and comments made to the court. See, they speak to you all with so much disrespect and get away with it that it carries over. And I'm going to say again, because I enjoy saying it, you're going
