establish an account to put any enforcement funds that we might receive into that account. This amendment simply creates that account, called the Tobacco Enforcement Fund, for that purpose and I would urge the adoption and the advancement of this amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Jensen. Discussion on the Jensen amendment? Senator Jensen, you're recognized to close. Senator Jensen waives closing. Question before us is adoption of Amendment 705 to LB 324. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Jensen's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The Jensen amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Senator Smith, I have nothing further on the bill, Senator.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: For discussion on LB 324, Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, thank you, Mr. President and members. My machine isn't working as fast as I'd like to have it. I'd like to ask Senator Jensen a question.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Jensen, would you yield?

SENATOR JENSEN: Yes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I was trying to print up your amendment. Did that create a Cash Fund on the side? I...I'm sorry I didn't catch all of what you said it did.

SENATOR JENSEN: Well, first of all, these are grant monies. There is...there are no monies in that fund at this time. Should there be, yes, it would be a Cash Fund.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: And this...your amendment did. I can't get it here and I...that does create a Cash Fund...

SENATOR JENSEN: Yes.
