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SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...that you will operate out for enforcement?
Did that what I...is that the way I understood it?

SENATOR JENSEN: Yes, strictly for...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: And it will be funded...

SENATOR JENSEN: ...strictly for enforcement purposes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: And it will be funded from...

SENATOR JENSEN: From this master settlement agreement.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: And it will be a given amount of money, like
how much?

SENATOR JENSEN: It would be given by a grant from...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Just for that reason.

SENATOR JENSEN: Yes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: So it may be a few thousand dollars.

SENATOR JENSEN: It could be. It could be for a million
dollars, but it's for a specific purpose to take care of a
specific incident.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay, if I'd had the amendment I would have
known. I just...

SENATOR JENSEN: Yeah, I'm sorry.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...couldn't get it on this and I wanted to
ask.

SENATOR JENSEN: I just might mention, as we are speaking here
on the floor, the Senate is debating this bill at this present
time. If you wanted to, you could pick it up on TV. So there's
still a lot of wrangling going on in Washington on this
situation.
