CLERK: (Read title of LB 411.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1092 of the Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting.
