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if we were dealing with a police shooting in Lincoln, I believe they could have the State Patrol, they could have the Lancaster County Sheriff's Office, or they could probably go to Omaha, get Douglas County, Omaha PD. If there was a killing here by the State Patrol, they could use Lancaster County, Lincoln Police Department, possibly even the FBI, if Senator Chambers wants to address that a little bit later. But I don't believe that any of these jurisdictions, if there was a killing in Lincoln or Omaha, that they would go to Scottsbluff. I don't believe that if there was one in Scottsbluff or in the western part of the state that they would come clear to Lincoln and Omaha to get these investigators. And I guess, that's what I basically wanted to talk about here was, are we trying to put something into this that isn't there? And I realize that they could do this, if they wanted to. But I don't believe that anybody would. And it's just...I'm not sure that we're staying on the issue that's really here, and that's the reason, I guess, I wanted to speak on it. And I do feel that what is being done here is probably proper, because I think there is situations where this happens. I hope that we don't have to use this, but I'm not naive enough to know that we're not going to. So, with that, I'm going to give my time to Senator Chambers, and he can, I guess, agree with me or steer me the right direction on what I said. So I'll yield my time to Senator Chambers.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President. Thank you, Senator Schmitt. You are correct. The reason, again, and Senator Brashear brought it into sharper focus. The term jurisdiction can be used. In the city of Omaha there's only one police force. There's only one police force in any given city. In Douglas County there is only one police agency for Douglas County, and that's the Sheriff's Division. So when you say the jurisdiction, it means the one that employs the officer or officers involved. I have tried to make it clear that I believe a special prosecutor will use discretion and not reach all the way across the state, because that would hinder the expeditious handling of this situation. That is what is being aimed at here, so that these matters don't stretch out interminably, that the appearance and sometimes the reality of a conflict of interest will not exist by having the agency which hires the
