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asked is already being processed and handled by these grand juries.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So all of these things are known and understood, apprehension and this about the natural deaths, that was asked for specifically by Lancaster County, which now is raising all these other issues to deal with the institutions where people in detention are likely to die from the natural causes. But if the grand jury determined that such was not the case, they are in a position to request the special prosecutor. But they deal with the judge. They could make a request of the judge.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Time.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Okay.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Beutler, on the motion to return LB 72 to Select File.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Lieutenant Governor Maurstad, Senator Chambers, I think, ...does he have additional times to speak on this issue?

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Chambers has one time left.

SENATOR BEUTLER: He has one. Okay, I would just defer then. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Are you waiving off?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes.
