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familiar with it until I started looking at Final Reading today and saw the amendment. So I feel very...I feel very disadvantaged. And it's unfortunate that we can't treat this amendment like we would any other amendment. I think there are legitimate things that could be done to improve this amendment, just like there are on most every suggested bill that I...that I present to the body. For example, the discussion that we've had about jurisdiction, and it says the special prosecutor shall select a team of three peace officers trained to investigate homicides from jurisdictions outside the jurisdiction where the death occurred. I would suggest a better language would be "from peace officers whose primary jurisdiction includes geographic territory outside the jurisdiction where the death occurred". That would clearly allow Douglas County Sheriff's Office to be involved in the team, it would clearly allow the State Patrol to be involved on the team. There is better language in two or three places, that, if we had the opportunity, we could improve it. We bring this back, we bring it back for specific amendment, that's the rule. So the only way we can improve the bill is to bring it back again and again, or at least again, until we are able to...to accommodate our concerns. I have a question about the timing of the appointment of the special prosecutor where...and the impanelment of the grand jury, where it's been certified by a physician that the death is from natural causes, and who calls or who prosecuted at that grand jury? Senator Brashear, would you yield to a question?

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Brashear.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Yes, Mr. President.

SENATOR BROMM: Senator Brashear, on the second page of the amendment, towards the bottom, line 24, it says, "a special prosecutor need not be appointed in those cases where the death has been certified by a licensed physician to be from natural causes". Now that would not include suicide, is that right?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: I don't believe so.

SENATOR BROMM: Okay. So, we have a...we have a death and we have a physician who says, this is from natural causes. What
