Senator Schellpeper. The question before us is the motion to return LB 72E to E & R...or, excuse me, to Select File. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 72E is returned to Select File for Amendment 852. Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on your amendment. (See AM0852 on page 1064 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President. Before I begin, I would like to ask Senator Bromm a question.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Bromm, would you yield?

SENATOR BROMM: Yes, I would.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Bromm, is LB 632 a bill of yours?

SENATOR BROMM: I'm terrible with numbers, it might be.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Is LB 229 a bill of yours?

SENATOR BROMM: It was, yes, it is.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Wasn't LB 229 put on the Speaker's priority list?

SENATOR BROMM: Yes, it is.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Did you amend it successfully into LB 632, which was further along in the process, just the other day?

SENATOR BROMM: Yes.
