SENATOR BROMM: But,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Members of the Legislature, what I'm doing is not unusual. And some of those who call my hand will have done the very same thing. Now I'm saying again, even having done that, he can raise the questions that he wants to and I'll answer them. But often when I undertake a bill, I'm like a lightning rod, and I draw a lot of attention, attention which is not justified on the basis of the bill. I'm going to be very brief in what I say, 'cause I'm not going to say it again. Those who have been involved in this situation that's covered by this bill are law enforcement people. They're the ones, not all of them, who have done the killings that have resulted in the convening of grand juries and which brings the bill before us today. They agreed to the amendment. I hear that all the time on this floor. We call these different groups together and they've agreed, then I'll hear somebody stand on the floor, you got so and so together? Yes, you got so and so together? Yeah. You got all the parties together? Yeah, and they agree, yeah. That's all there is to it. Now questions are being raised relative to how the existing law is enforced, and that wasn't even a question to those who are attacking the bill now, like some of the hidden people in Lancaster County, because they know what the existing law is, they know how it works, because they have applied it several times. They understand the grand jury procedures, if people on this floor don't. I have explained those procedures several times and have invited questions on any aspect of it which is not understood. I have explained why the language that's in the bill is in the bill. I filed all of those amendments as I got new versions. I didn't just wait and then suddenly spring all this on everybody. Jim Janssen was keeping track of it in Omaha, because he had minions trying to do various things. And if I find out that he is behind this, I'm going to point out the fact that there is a complaint pending against him, before the Bar Association right now, because of his mishandling of a situation involving a grand jury. I'm going to lay everything on the record from now. And I'm going to make it clear why some people may do the things that they do. But at this point, I'm going to ask that the body adopt this amendment, then young Senator Smith will make the appropriate motion to readvance the bill. And then all those
