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our committee's best estimate of what the impacts are going to be and whether or not any one of the NRDs would be unable to meet their obligations if they didn't receive additional revenues outside of the motor vehicle tax, and only one of them, Nemaha, by our estimation, is impacted, and they would be impacted in the amount of \$25,000. One NRD would be impacted, and that would be in the amount of \$25,000. Now, it's true, they'd have to raise property taxes, but at the same time county and municipal taxes would go down because of the way we calculate restricted funds under 989. So the aggregate shouldn't be any increase in local property taxes due to the effect of the passage of this bill. Now, Senator Beutler brings you an amendment and suggests this is one place where we could add revenues for NRDs, and where we could subtract from the revenues that go to municipalities and counties. The fund that Senator Beutler wants you to add money to distributes dollars on the basis of who levies the most. The aid formulas for the counties and municipalities are varied. They depend on population, in part, for their components, and in another component they depend on gross valuation. They're a mixed bag. All three of them are different. In addition, the counties have two other aid programs, and the municipalities have three other aid programs. And, in addition to the aid program that Senator Beutler points out to you for NRDs, they have four other aid programs. Are you getting any idea? We have not made a comprehensive effort to integrate the impacts and the various formulas in any of the aid programs for any of the political subdivisions, except for schools. And if we are now forced to do that, I don't think that would be bad for the state. But we can't do that on General File in this body. And if you want to accuse the Revenue Committee of having let you down because we didn't bring you a comprehensive proposal to restructure all of the revenues from the state for counties, for cities and NRDs in this session, we'll do it next year. And we can do it next year without hurting any of them in the process. But, if that's what you want us to do, and in some respects I think that's what should be done, it needs to be done in the context other than General File, because Senator Wehrbein says he doesn't have the information to do that, I don't have the information to suggest to you ways to do that and what the impacts are. I understand that Senator Beutler is concerned about the NRDs. Senator Kristensen is concerned about the ESU...or the community
