PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The house is under call. Would senators please record your presence. Would unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Senator Redfield, how would you like to proceed? Are you going to accept call-in votes, or would you like a roll call vote? Call-in votes have been authorized. Believe we'll wait for everyone to please check in, then we will accept call-in votes. So, members, please record your presence. Roll call vote has been requested. The house is under call.
