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SENATOR STUHR:    Yes.

SENATOR SCHIMEK:    ...it might be possible that others on the floor do, too, I don't know. But, first of all, and I've been reading a little bit about this particular bill as the year has gone along, and it was a \$6 million price tag, originally. Is that correct?

SENATOR STUHR:    Yes, that's correct.

SENATOR SCHIMEK:    And...and what has been cut out of this bill to take it down to the \$3.2 million that it will now be per year, as I understand it?

SENATOR STUHR:    Right. Just the reality of how the Legislature was feeling and that comparing other states' funding for this area, we spend probably less than 11 dollars per student, compared to as high as 3 and 4 hundred dollars that some states spend.

SENATOR SCHIMEK:    Okay.

SENATOR STUHR:    And so it was our thought this year to at least try to give some additional funding, because equipment is old, that we could give some influx of some additional funding in this area.

SENATOR SCHIMEK:    Okay, so what I think I hear you telling me,...

SENATOR STUHR:    And so...

SENATOR SCHIMEK:    ...Senator, is that there was no particular program or aspect of the bill that was cut out of the original proposal.

SENATOR STUHR:    No.

SENATOR SCHIMEK:    It was just less money...

SENATOR STUHR:    It's just making do with less.
