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see, I've got four children who now are grown and I didn't turn my children loose like those little flowers that...dandelions flower and then they make those little pieces of cotton that float through the air when the wind blows them. I didn't expect my children to be blown here and there and be taught things by other people. As their father, it was my responsibility, not just to talk and lecture, but to show by my example the kind of life that a person should live if he or she truly believes what is being said. So when you all go back to school, you ought to ask about this gambling. And if it is so good that the proceeds can fund education, if gambling is so good that it can be conducted by the churches, ask why you cannot engage in this good thing. It helps the churches. Why can't it help you? Maybe you'd go to church more if they'd let you gamble. Maybe you'd not cut classes if they'd let you gamble. And if you came to school on time every day they give you a free lottery ticket. And if you don't act up in class they give you five lottery tickets, and I bet we'd have much better discipline in the schools. And for those who never miss a day of school, who never smart off to the teacher, at the end of the term will get 25 lottery tickets. Now why don't you ask them to do that? You all know you'd like that instead of somebody saying, sit up and be quiet because I'm your teacher and I told you to sit up and be quiet. It's time for us to give the example, because when you young people are not here you're talked about all the time. Senators are always saying, we got to do this and that for our young people; we got to set an example for them; we got to pass laws to criminalize their conduct and punish, punish, punish because that's the only way you can deal with young people. Then they wonder why you all don't pay attention and don't want to hear old people. You see an old geezer, such as myself, if I was walking down the street with a cane and the first thing you want to do is kick my cane out from under me. If we were to stand up and practice what we preach, we would show the young people a better way. We would demonstrate that living life according to certain principles is of value. But if those of us who claim to know...
