SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, it looks like we'll probably need a call of the house and roll call vote.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Question before the body is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The house is under call. Would all unexcused members please return to the Chamber. Would all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call.
