support, then it needs to come out of committee and have the body look at that issue on its own. And this...we are talking about LB 495, which is the Education and Career Preparation Act. Also referring to the purpose of funds that would be used to provide grants under the innovation grant program, it does specifically say that these grants could be used for instructional programs which bring about improvement in the quality of education. I believe that the mentoring program has some good points about it. But I also believe that if students had the opportunity to take some of the vocational courses that are offered, and I mentioned those this morning, particularly in the area of family and consumer sciences, they have the opportunity to do some parenting courses, to look at child development. These are issues that relate very much to the mentoring bill, taking responsibilities, parents taking responsibilities for the children that they produce. I support the Chair's ruling. Thank you.

**SPEAKER KRISTENSEN:** Senator Bohlke.

**SENATOR BOHLKE:** Yes, Mr. Speaker and members. Senator Chambers, if...ah-ha, I have his attention. I'm not asking you to answer something, I'm just telling you all that often times we need to recognize that Senator Chambers is looking on down the road. And possibly is supporting this, because if we support...is...or is opposed to this, if we believe that you should only use the pot of money in order to make something germane, anything from General Funds, anything you wanted to amend into a bill would be germane. And so I rise to support the Chair and saying that is certainly not a reason to make a bill germane. And if we start down that road, it would certainly open up being...amending about anything you wanted onto any bill. The other thing I do need to respond to is, yes, this is in the Education Committee. I was a cosigner with Senator Bruning on this. But I think there's a very valid question that I would raise, and I'm not sure Senator Chambers asked Senator Stuhr if she had checked with the Governor, I think the issue should be checking with Tom Osborne to see if he would want to use the gambling money for a mentoring program. I'm not so sure of that answer. And then the last thing that I would say that if, Senator Bruning, we had a child out of the marriage of Wally and June Cleaver, they probably...that child
