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the order of FA59, followed by (FA)58, followed by (FA)60, followed by (FA)61. Is that correct?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: I believe that's correct, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Schimek, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you, Mr. President. I'm not clear on what FA59 is. I thought you said (1) on both of those amendments.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: If I did, I misspoke, Senator.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Could you...could you clarify please.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: FA59 should be subsection (2) only.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay, thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Schimek, thank you. Let me...if I could have your attention again, let me review this again so that it's clear for everyone, and I'll do it in the order of FA58 through FA61. First of all, FA58 is subsection (2) of the committee amendments. FA59 are Sections 1, 3, 9, 10, and 11. FA60 would be subsections (4), (5), and (6) of the committee amendments. And FA61 would be subsections (7) and (8). Senator Chambers, Senator Brashear, if you would nod and acknowledge that that's correct, and we will proceed. Do you want to proceed in numerical order then, FA58 through 61?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Yes, please, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Is that agreed? First item then for discussion is the FA58 of the divided committee amendments. Senator Schellpeper, you're first recognized, followed by Senators Schimek, Kiel, Beutler, and Chambers. (FA58 is found on page 1183 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Mr. Chairman and members. The committee amendments, as Senator Brashear has stated, are basically designed to improve the bill. I think the bill, after
