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SENATOR SCHIMEK: And what was their...do you have any recollection of what that number...how many applications we're talking about here?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Just...just a second.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Certainly.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Keep talking and then I'll get that...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay.

SENATOR JANSSEN: I don't have it with me.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: One of the reasons I'm asking these questions is because I want to go through the bill a little bit and identify all the work that the Patrol has to do on this licensing. And Senator Janssen has an answer for me now?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Yes, they...Senator Schimek, they based that on the assumption of 18 to 19 thousand.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Eighteen to nineteen thousand. I assume they've looked at some other states probably to arrive at those figures.

SENATOR JANSSEN: They took it a guess. Now, in Wyoming I think there were only something like 5,000 permits issued. I don't...I don't know whether that was the number that they had or not, but that's the amount of permits they issued...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...that first year.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay.

SENATOR JANSSEN: And Texas was a hundred and...I think 165,000 permits.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: All right. Thank you.
