SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: ...he's a better jockey than what I am.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: We're going to find out. But, at any rate, this amount of the fee was raised from \$75 to \$100 because it was determined that the \$75 would not bring in enough money to fund what the bill required. There would be a shortfall, in other words, with the \$75.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: We don't really know that, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But it was suspected that...

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Maybe 75 would be too high.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But it was suspected that that could happen so...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: What objection would you have to raising the fee to \$400, or a thousand, which I haven't offered?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Well, there's...there's no reason to do that. We're trying to keep the bill revenue neutral and that's what it would do. Long as you keep it revenue neutral, it doesn't use any state funds, so why would you penalize the individuals that wanted a license?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, if we're talking...
