SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...senators, can have telemarketers calling them in their offices? All of that can be done under the law, but I don't like it and I don't have to take it. But I'm not going to be like that man in the movie, which I didn't see but I heard so much about, where he went to the window, opened it and hollered I am sick of it, or something like that, and I'm mad as Hades and I won't take it anymore. Now I'm not going to be as impotent as that. I'm going to study and I'm going to pick my targets and I am not going to be like those silly people in the Dracula movies who think that a cross is going to frighten the vampire. Everybody knows vampires are not afraid of crosses, but the stake, the wooden stake, works...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...every time.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. There are lots of question in my mind about the fiscal note and about the true costs of this, but I think a lot of them are very difficult to get your hand around because a lot of the factors are unknown as far as how many people might be participating, who does the training, those kinds of things. So I'm just going to say I've got some reservations about this thing fiscally and, in addition, I'd like to make the comment that, as I figured it, this may cost us about \$76,000 the first year in funds above and beyond, and that's about how much my Volunteer Service Commission was going to cost and I think that would do the state a lot more good. (Laugh) But having said that, there are a couple other things I want to call attention to in the bill. On page 19, in subsection (5), it talks about all the places that a licensee cannot carry a gun into, a hand...a concealed handgun, and I'm going to read them. You'll have to bear with me. But it says: police station, sheriff or
