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will never know the difference until somebody pulls out that gun and starts shooting at somebody. I just can't imagine how we're going to enforce this act. I think it's a bad piece of legislation. I cannot support it and I hope that you will not either. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, as Yogi Berra said, this is deja vu all over again. We were debating a bill like this and the lobbyist for the NRA or somebody went around, and Senator Dwite Pedersen I know will remember this, and said, we just want a vote on this bill just to advance it, that's all we want and we're not going to do anything, so vote for cloture and you'll get some NRA support when you run for election. And people switched and voted for cloture. And I'll bet they're doing it again. But it's early in the session and I'm watching. I have that eye on the entire panorama, and if the lobbyist wants to know what I am talking about, pull out a dollar bill and look at that pyramid and you'll see that all-seeing eye. But, Senator Smith, my eye is different from the ordinary eye. With every other person, the eye that beholds everything else beholdeth not itself. That limitation is not on me. And I know how to play this game and I will not be the first one to cry uncle. Things are principle with me, p-r-i-n-c-i-p-l-e. With a lobbyist it's principal with p-a-l on the end. Now, if a lobbyist has so much principal invested in this that he's willing to chuck the rest of his clients, his other principals, that's fine. That lobbyist and I will have a chance to match wills and see who is going to stand without blinking or without backing. I'm not paid to do what I do. Yeah, we get \$12,000. That's not pay. That's an insult. Lobbyists get paid handsomely and they need that money. They count on that money. Without it, they can't live the way they live. They cannot throw the lavish spreads. They cannot intimidate senators. They cannot talk about doing things against them in their districts when they run for reelection. They cannot hire telemarketer-type operatives to call their offices. So I, as the senior member of this Legislature, as the man foisted, having the term foisted on him on him of "dean of the Legislature", am going to show you what a dean of the Legislature can do and will do. And when I say these kind of
