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SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR KIEL: ...84 percent were not related to the commission of another felony. So what do we see with this? We see that most often women who are victims of homicide are victims of homicide by a man that they know and they are also victims of homicide by a man they know, not in the commission of another felony, not in the commission of another crime, but as the result of an argument, and usually by a firearm. This bill sends the wrong message. It says we can solve our problems if only we have a gun and, unfortunately, women are most often the victims of that particular kind of thinking. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Janssen.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature. I just want to rise and ask a few questions maybe and make a few statements. Senator Schimek had wondered about school events and so on, you know, if people would be...would be flocking into these events with handguns, with concealed handgun. You know, how do you know, you know, how do you know that that isn't happening right now? No one is checking at the doors to see if people are coming in there with a concealed weapon right now. And I...what leads you to believe that there would be a big influx of this with concealed weapons? A lot of the people that carry concealed weapons now, I hope a lot of those people would see it fit to go ahead and get a license and go through the hoops that people have to obtain this. And, there again, part of that is instructions on how to handle the weapon, not to get provoked and so on and so forth. So I just can't see where there is going to be hundreds of people going in...going in to sporting events. First place, you're not supposed to do it. You're not supposed to do it now. How do we know how many people are doing it now? There's no way that we know that unless you're going to put up a metal detector and check everyone coming in. I think when you go into the court, I'd seen metal detectors sitting around here, they go through that. And we don't have a concealed carry now. How many weapons are found when you go through? I have no idea. Neither do I know or does anyone else know how many weapons are being carried by the general public right now, have no idea. We had no idea how many hand guns there are. I would imagine there are
