SENATOR BROMM: Thank you, Mr. President. The action that I would be asking the body then to take at this time would be to reconsider the previous action of passage of the bill and so an affirmative vote would support my motion for reconsideration for reasons I've previously stated. I ask for you to support the reconsideration of the passage of 101.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Discussion. Senator Bromm, you're recognized to close. Senator Bromm waives closing. The question before us is the reconsideration of the final vote on LB 101. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 42 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to reconsider.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is agreed to.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Bromm would move to return LB 101 to Select File for a specific amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you very much, Mr. President. Colleagues, thank you for your indulgence. The amendment that I'm proposing to return the bill for now is printed in the Journal on page 1193 and it simply provides, again, that the Governor will make the appointments rather than the chairperson of the Natural Resources and the chairperson of the Agriculture Committee, and that any legislators who are members will be ex officio, nonvoting members of this committee, and that's the amendment that I am asking you to return it to adopt. If there are any questions, I'll be glad to try to answer them. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Discussion on AM0976 to LB 101. Seeing none, Senator Bromm, you're recognized to close. Senator Bromm waives closing. The question is to return LB 101 to Select File for AM0976. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 39 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.
