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LB 476

SENATOR JANSSEN: A handgun, one, a handgun.

SENATOR HILGERT: A handgun per permit?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Per permit.

SENATOR HILGERT: Or just a handgun at a time?

SENATOR JANSSEN: A handgun at a time, a handgun for a permit.

SENATOR HILGERT: Well, those could be two different things if you have two permits.

SENATOR JANSSEN: All right, now you have to take training.

SENATOR HILGERT: Okay.

SENATOR JANSSEN: You have to go back and pay for the training again if you want to use another weapon besides the one that you're qualified in. Then you would be qualified. Not sure about getting another...another qualification permit from the State Patrol, but any weapon that you'd have to call, you know, carry one at a time,...

SENATOR HILGERT: Only one at a time.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...but you...one at a time and you would have to be...you would have to be qualified in the weapon you are carrying at that time.

SENATOR HILGERT: Senator, do you think most Nebraskans are in favor of this bill?

SENATOR JANSSEN: I believe so.

SENATOR HILGERT: Okay.

SENATOR JANSSEN: A majority of them are.

SENATOR HILGERT: Majority? Thank you very much.
