SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay, thank you, Senator Kiel. I will support that in lieu of moving that actual fee to a higher...a higher point, which is what I think we should do. I would like to ask Senator Janssen a question or two. And I guess when we...when we started talking about the training aspect of this bill, I went back and looked at the training section, or part of it anyway, that's on page 41. It talks about law enforcement officers. And I've gone back to Section 81-1414, which is discussed on page 41. And I told Senator Janssen I was going to ask about this. I guess my question is, Senator Janssen, they're talking about law enforcement officers here whose appointment is not conditioned on satisfactory completion of training, under 81-1414. Who would that be? Don't all law enforcement officers have to take this training? Am I reading that wrong?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Would you yield, Senator Janssen?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Yes. Satis...all right....

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Would these be temporary officers who...but it says, is not conditioned on satisfactory completion of training.

SENATOR JANSSEN: All right. Shall be exempt from such...Subsection 1, let me read back again.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: And...and then, Senator Janssen, and I'm not going to take a lot of time here, my second question also regard...is in regard to this particular language, where it says that if they're not...if they don't have to comply with this subsection while off duty, or they don't have to while they're off duty, at the discretion of their law enforcement agency supervisor. So then my second question is, does this bill say, I don't remember seeing it anywhere, that law enforcement officers had to carry a gun off duty? Am I reading this wrong?

SENATOR JANSSEN: They have to carry what?
