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it strikes "one hundred", inserts three hundred and fifty.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Members of the Legislature and Senator Janssen, I've been trying to increase that fee and I started by offering an amount of \$500. That was not acceptable and those who support the bill have said repeatedly that they did not want to price this license to carry this hidden gun out of the reach of people who want to do so. I have been bringing that amount down in increments of \$50. I'm now down to \$350. I believe we all know...oh, let me ask Senator Janssen a question first,...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Janssen,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...if I may.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: ...would you yield?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Janssen, you have a long weekend to kick your feet up, think this over, chill out, mellow down and give some serious thought to what I've been discussing, so I will ask you now. How large an increase in this fee are you willing to accept? You said \$10, but we know that was just...

SENATOR JANSSEN: Well...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...because we were talking crazy Thursday.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Senator Chambers, I guess maybe I've always been a little bit...a little bit crazy. I think we all are from time to time. But I'm afraid to tell you that I am still on that \$10 increase, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Thank you, Senator Janssen. At least you're straightforward and you don't change with the times. I mean you don't change just because time passes, let me say that the correct way. Members of the Legislature, since we're starting a fresh week, I want to make it clear that I am opposed to this bill. I don't want to fly a false flag and give the impression that there's anything that can be done to this bill
