SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, you can answer that. Let me discuss it 'cause you're not a mind reader. Members of the Legislature, I would be a...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...stoned fool to tell a white cop in Omaha I've got a gun concealed on my person, then going to pull the gun out in my hand when he's there and got a gun in his hand. He'd blow me away, and dead men tell no tales. I believe they've thrown guns down in instances where black men were killed. I believe in the case of Marvin Ammons, even though it was Ammons's own gun in the holster, because of the placement of it and what witnesses said about Ammons' hands at the time he was shot, I believe the cops got that gun out of his car and put it by his right hand. And this kind of stuff in this bill is what's supposed to make it good? It's crazy, brothers and sisters, downright insane. I hope my colleague from Senator...former Senator Hall's district is paying close attention.
