SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Why don't you ask him.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Oh, okay.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Janssen.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: I don't want to put words in his mouth.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Ask him. He's...is that right, Senator Janssen? If I...if someone would carry a concealed handgun into a theater, you said that was illegal?

SENATOR JANSSEN: If it's posted, yes.

SENATOR HARTNETT: The theater has to post it?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Yes.

SENATOR HARTNETT: What if...what if this person brings the handgun into the theater, what's...and someone discovers that he has this, he or she, has this handgun in there concealed, what happens? What's the penalty?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Well,...

SENATOR HARTNETT: Is there a penalty on this person? Say a law enforcement person discovers that this person has this handgun, a concealed handgun in their possession in a theater. What is the penalty for this person? Because you said it was illegal, what's the penalty?

SENATOR JANSSEN: It would be the same penalty as it is right now.

SENATOR HARTNETT: What is it?

SENATOR JANSSEN: It's a misdemeanor.

SENATOR HARTNETT: A misdemeanor.
