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SENATOR JANSSEN: Yes, Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Senator Janssen, you may not know the answers to these and I...but I don't know where to really turn for the answers and perhaps you can correct me. I had a call or two over the weekend concerning this, that this bill would, let's say, I should say, would damage the ability of a person to carry a weapon now in the open. In other words, if...I understand, it's legal to carry a weapon on the car seat now in the open.

SENATOR JANSSEN: That's right.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: If you were...if this bill was to pass, would that inhibit that ability to carry a weapon in the open under the present circumstances? That's the question...thrust of my question.

SENATOR JANSSEN: No, it would not. In the best of my ability to answer that question, Senator Wehrbein, no.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: So you're saying that if this were to pass those that are carrying weapons now legally in gun racks and so forth and so forth, this would not...it would not inhibit that ability at all. This would...this creates another issue of a concealed weapon carry which is spelled out in your bill, as I understand it.

SENATOR JANSSEN: That would not prohibit them from carrying a weapon on the outside in plain site. Otherwise you would...anyone that would be hunting would be in violation of this too...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Right, so whatever is legal...

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...and that would not be.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...now would not be affected by this bill.

SENATOR JANSSEN: In my opinion, that's right, Senator.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Only this really affect the concealed weapon part.
